

The Awful Egyptians - Jewellery

Ancient Egyptians of both sexes and all social classes loved jewellery - bracelets, earrings, collar pieces, anklets, armbands and rings. The rich wore gold jewellery, the poor wore jewellery made of copper. The jewellery was decorated with semi-precious stones and coloured glass.



Instructions for collar

- 1) Copy the template onto card or paper and cut out (if using paper, stick onto cereal box card or draw round onto foam)
- 2) Make holes in the collar where the dots are to thread wool through.
- 3) Cut out some geometric shapes from coloured card/foam/paper and decorate your collar
- 4) Tie wool through the holes and wear
