

The Savage Stone Age - Hand Stencil

Stone Age people often decorated the walls of their caves with paintings. One type of cave art was hand painting. There were two types - hand prints and hand stencils (where the hand was placed on the wall and pigment was sprayed/daubed around it).

Try making your own stone age hand stencil.

- 1) Draw round your hand on card and cut out.
- 2) Place the card on a sheet of paper.
- 3) Put some paint in a dish and use a sponge to daub paint over the edges of your hand shape.
- 4) Remove your card hand stencil carefully to reveal a perfect hand shape.
