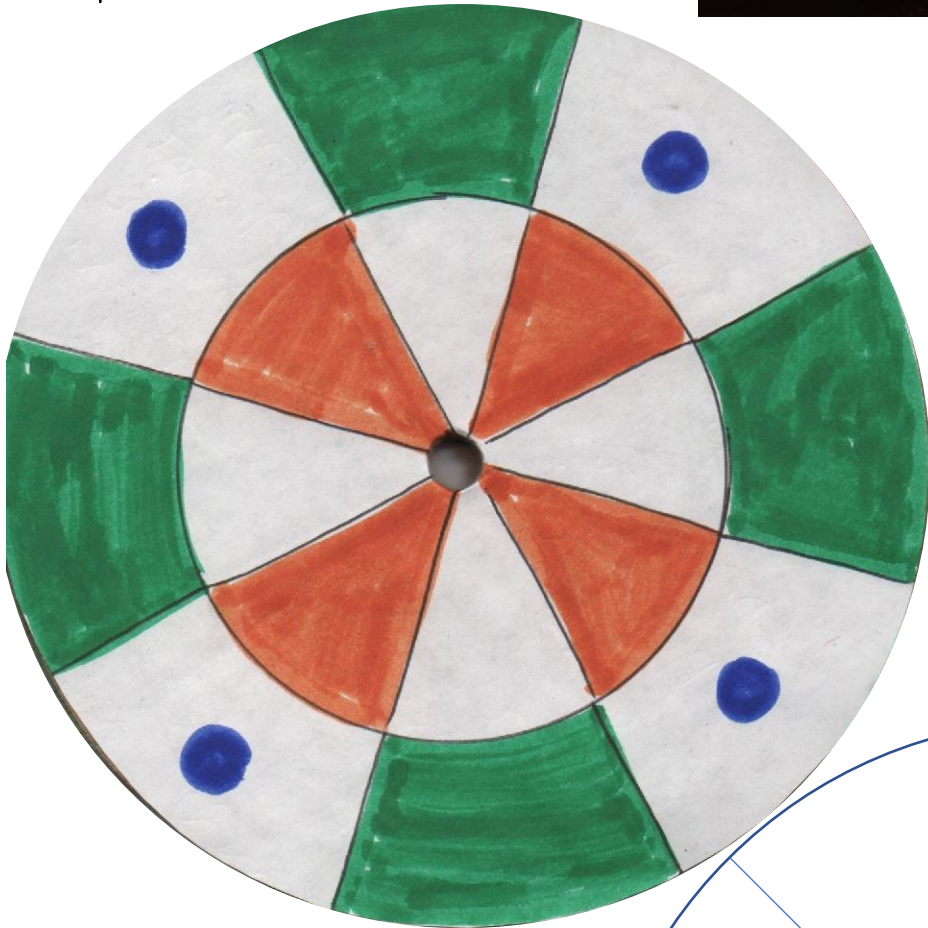


The Vile Victorians – Schools
