

The Ruthless Romans – Planet Crown

The people who lived in the Roman Empire were interested in both Astronomy and Astrology and for some, the boundaries between the two were blurred. They were aware of Venus, Mercury, Mars, Saturn and Jupiter (named after Roman gods) as well as star constellations that they could see with the naked eye.

Instructions for Planet Crown

- Fold your A4 sheet of card/paper in half lengthways and cut along the fold. Join the two pieces end to end to form a long strip for the headband.
- Stick the planets along the headband (you will need to print off page 2 and cut out the pieces).
- Add extra stars (self-adhesive or drawn on using metallic pens).
- Staple the headband together to fit your head.

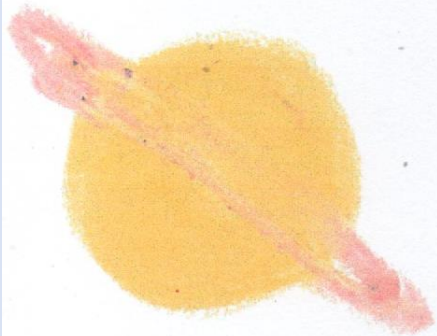
